Fresno OVERVIEW

- Fresno VAMC is a 500,000 GSF Level 1C hospital consisting of 57 inpatient hospital beds, a 60 bed nursing home and several outpatient and administrative buildings. The Fresno VAMC is planning for expansion of its outpatient facilities to a 9 acre property in Clovis, CA
- The Chief Engineer's primary responsibility is the oversite of the facility's maintenance operations and expansion and renovation program.



Title: Parking Structure Rust Mitigation

Timeline: Construction award FY19-1, (\$25K-\$100K)

Scope: Install water runoff features on the upper deck of two story parking structure. Remove/replace rusted non-structural elements Restripe parking stalls.



Title: Correct Mental Health Deficiencies

Timeline: Construction award FY19-2, (\$500K-\$1M)

Scope: Security/safety emphasis. Mental Health is located in Bldg 12, 5th floor. Scope includes window repl, sally port entry, door modifications, hardware upgrades, cameras, and other misc elec and HVAC elements.

Title: Replace MRI Wing AHU

Timeline: Construction award FY19-2, (\$250K-\$500K)

Scope: MRI Wing is a 3 story structure with a rooftop Air Handling Unit. The unit is old and in need of replacement.



Title: Add Emergency Power to MRI Wing

Timeline: Construction award FY19-2, (\$500K-\$1M)

Scope: MRI Wing is a 3 story structure housing Endoscopy, MRI, and Out-patient Pharmacy. Additional emergency power circuits are necessary for efficient operations.

Title: Water Monitoring System

Timeline: Construction award FY19-4, (\$500K-\$1M)

Scope: Project is legionella related. Installs domestic water monitoring elements and injection points for mitigation/sanitization efforts – campus wide.



Title: Renovate Unfinished Space in B3

Timeline: Construction award FY19-4, (\$25K-\$100K)

Scope: Renovate approx 1000SF of unfinished space on the 3rd floor of Bldg 12, Area B3. Currently utilities partially roughed-in. All trades involved.



Title: Replace CLC Transformer

Timeline: Construction award FY19-3, (\$250K-\$500K)

Scope: 25KV/208V external transformer continues a gradual list and is in need of replacement. The transformer serves a 60 resident Community Living Center (nursing home).
